



Sponsor a Child

Give orphan children the chance of a future

It costs **just £10 per month** to sponsor an orphan or vulnerable child to attend one of our After School Clubs in South Africa.

Together with our partner charity Thembaletu, we run three After School Clubs which support 300 children every day. These clubs are not like the ones in the UK, where kids just go and play after school often waiting to be picked up by parents. Many of these vulnerable children do not have parents. They may live with relatives. They may live with older siblings or they may be the older sibling and struggling to run a household for their younger brothers and sisters. All the children attending are considered vulnerable. Their future is grim. So these clubs are a life-line, a safe haven, providing food, support, education and guidance.

is the cost of just four lovely lattes per month!

£10

per month is the equivalent of just 35p per day.

For just £10 per month, a child gets:

- A vital nutritious meal – the only other meal they may receive is the one at school.
- Educational support in Maths and English and help with homework.
- Counselling for grief and trauma from a qualified Social Worker.
- Crucial life skills education such as sewing, cooking, gardening, debating and sexual health education, giving them greater independence for the future.
- Important time to relax, play and be a child in a safe environment.
- Guidance and assistance with taking medication, assessment of their home conditions and help with school uniform / equipment.


How it works

Every penny you donate by supporting our sponsorship programme provides the After School Clubs with a reliable, regular income to help cover main running costs such as staff salaries and provision of educational activities and nutritional food for the children. Your money will support all the children at all three After School Clubs and allow them to have full access to all of our services.

In return, we will keep you informed on how your donation is giving vulnerable children the chance of a better future with regular, twice yearly updates on the progress of the clubs.

Additionally, if you want to, you can select to hear directly from one of the many children who benefit from the clubs. Along with your regular club updates, you will receive personalised letters from the child you are sponsoring. You will also have the chance to write directly to your sponsored child, giving you the opportunity to see first hand the impact of your regular donation on a child's life.
